O R D E R

Applicant Robert Christopher Reade has established to the satisfaction of the hearing panel and this Court that his application for reinstatement should be granted, subject to the conditions set forth below. Specifically, Applicant provided clear and convincing evidence to rebut the presumption against reinstatement in Rule 64(b), Rules of the Supreme Court. Pursuant to Rule 65,

IT IS ORDERED that Applicant shall provide the Presiding Disciplinary Judge with documents establishing that he has been released from supervision in his criminal case in the United States District Court for the District of Nevada.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant shall provide the Presiding Disciplinary Judge with documents establishing that he has been reinstated to the active practice of law in the State of Nevada, along with any documents ordered by the Nevada Supreme Court in its reinstatement order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon receipt of the documents called for above, the Presiding Disciplinary Judge shall sign an order of reinstatement which shall include the terms of probation below.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon the effective date of reinstatement, Applicant shall be placed on probation for one year pursuant to Rule 60(a)(5), under the terms and conditions as listed below:

1. Within thirty days of reinstatement, Applicant shall contact the State Bar's Compliance Monitor to enter into a Member Assistance Program (MAP) contract. Applicant shall comply with all the terms of
