O R D E R

Applicant Cox seeks an extension of the five-year requirement for admission to the practice of law after sitting for the bar examination under Rule 37(a)(1), Rules of the Supreme Court. **IT IS ORDERED** that the request to extend the five-year requirement under Rule 37(a)(1) is granted.
