

the Arizona State Bar who has been in good standing for at least 15 years indicating that member's agreement to serve as a practice monitor under the terms of this order. The practice monitor will supervise Petitioner in the practice of law and will confer regularly to address substantive and procedural matters in Petitioner's cases. Such supervision will include, as the practice monitor deems necessary, observing and consulting with Petitioner on in-court proceedings and reviewing disclosures, and also reviewing pleadings before filing. In the letter, the practice monitor must also acknowledge the practice monitor's obligations to comply with ER 8.3 by immediately reporting professional misconduct to Bar counsel, and the practice monitor must agree to notify State Bar counsel if practice monitor terminates the agreement with Petitioner. Any costs incurred shall be at Petitioner's expense.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED Petitioner will associate with co-counsel on all new matters.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED Petitioner will comply with reasonable Bar requests for information regarding Petitioner's practice pending resolution of the appeal.
