O R D E R

Applicant ALEXIA C. BROOKS seeks an extension of the five-year requirement for admission to the practice of law after sitting for the bar examination. Rule 37(a)(1), Rules of the Supreme Court. The Committee on Character and Fitness does not object, but it responded that it is unable to recommend that a waiver be granted without an explanation for her delay in seeking admission. Applicant filed her application to be admitted to the practice of law with the Committee before the expiration of her examination results. The Committee, through its deliberation and investigation of that application, can obtain answers to its questions about Applicant's delay. Upon consideration,

IT IS ORDERED that the request to extend the five-year requirement under Rule 37(a)(1) is **GRANTED**. The time period for Applicant's admission shall be extended for nine months from the date of this order.
