O R D E R

Applicant ROBBY S. PINNAMANENI seeks an extension of the five-year requirement for admission to the practice of law after sitting for the bar examination. Rule 37(a)(1), Rules of the Supreme Court. The Committee on Character and Fitness did not object, but it responded that it could not recommend an enlargement of the time limit without proof of the explanation for his delay in seeking an extension. Applicant filed his medical records and a letter from his doctor to support his request. They have been sealed by the Court. Upon consideration,

IT IS ORDERED that the request to extend the five-year requirement under Rule 37(a)(1) is **GRANTED**. The time period for Applicant's admission shall be extended for nine months from the date of this order.
