O R D E R

Pursuant to Rule 70(g), Rules of the Supreme Court, Applicant Chenal filed in this Court an "Amended Motion to Seal Portions of the Applicant's Reinstatement File and State Bar Files." Former Rule 70(g) provided that a panelist, hearing officer, the Commission, or this Court could issue an order sealing a portion of the record or State Bar file. The current rule provides, however, that the request to seal be presented to the presiding disciplinary judge. While this reinstatement matter proceeded under the former rules, the Court finds that Applicant Chenal's request to seal should be determined by the presiding disciplinary judge in the first instance.
