O R D E R

Applicant MARK K. BRIGGS has established to the satisfaction of the Hearing Panel and this Court that his application for reinstatement should be granted. Pursuant to Rule 65 of the Rules of the Supreme Court,

IT IS ORDERED that MARK K. BRIGGS is reinstated as an active member of the State Bar of Arizona effective the date of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon the effective date of reinstatement MARK K. BRIGGS shall be placed on probation for a period of two years, under the terms and conditions as listed below:

1. Within thirty days of reinstatement, Applicant shall contact the Director of LOMAP and submit to an assessment. Applicant shall thereafter enter into a LOMAP contract based on the recommendations made by the LOMAP director or designee. Applicant shall obtain an approved practice monitor.

2. The State Bar shall report material violations of the terms of probation pursuant to Rule 60(a)(5), Ariz. R. Sup. Ct., and a hearing may be held within thirty days to determine if the terms of probation have been violated and if an additional sanction should be imposed. The burden of proof shall be on the State Bar to prove non-compliance by a preponderance of the evidence.
