O R D E R

Clarence Edward Witson filed a "Motion to Modify a Term of Petitioner's Conditional Admission." The Committee on Character and Fitness and the State Bar filed responses to the motion and oppose Witson's request to terminate the requirement that he participate in random biological fluid testing. The State Bar has no objection, however, to reducing the frequency of the testing to once per month. Upon consideration of the motion and the responses,

IT IS ORDERED granting, in part, the "Motion to Modify a Term of Petitioner's Conditional Admission."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Clarence Edward Witson will be required to provide biological fluid specimens that are screened for EtG Alcohol, amphetamine, cocaine, opiates, phencyclidine, and THC (marijuana), a minimum of once per month on a random basis.
