Clerk of Court Passport Services Temporarily Moving to Main Pima County Superior Court Building

PIMA COUNTY, AZ. - To help slow the spread of the COVID-19 virus, the Office of the Clerk of the Superior Court in Pima County is temporarily and immediately moving passport services from their satellite office at 240 N. Stone to their main office, located on the first floor of the Pima County Superior Courthouse, at 110 W. Congress, in Tucson.

While individuals may continue to apply for a U.S. passport at the Clerk of Court's office, those who do so must be prepared to expect significant delays in processing and receipt of the passport, according to information available on the U.S. Department of State website, [Travel.State.Gov](https://travel.state.gov). The government has restricted most passport services to customers with a "qualified life or death emergency" who need a passport for immediate travel outside of the U.S.

Passport applications are accepted between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. only. The Clerk's office prefers an appointment be made in advance and asks the public to review the details on their website, at www.agave.cosc.pima.gov to ensure they have the proper documentation and fee payments available upon arrival.

Further, they request that individuals who are ill do not visit the courthouse.
