Due to concern for the spread of COVID-19 in the general population, the Governor of the State of Arizona has declared a statewide emergency. Additionally, the Arizona Supreme Court has issued Administrative Order No. 2020-47 authorizing limitations of court operations during a public health emergency.

Therefore, to avoid all in-person proceedings to the greatest extent possible consistent with core constitutional rights, for the Chandler Municipal Court docket held at the Tempe Municipal Court, on the East Valley Regional Veterans Court docket, and until further order of the Arizona Supreme Court, pursuant to Administrative Order No. 2020-47,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

- (a) All out-of-custody Veterans Court hearings currently scheduled for March 18, 2020 through May 12, 2020 are continued for eight weeks.
- (b) All in-custody Veterans Court hearings will proceed as currently scheduled.
- (c) For all criminal cases subject to this Order, time is excluded for the purpose of calculating time under Rules 8 and 27, *Rules of Criminal Procedure*, between March 18, 2020 and March 31, 2020, subject to further direction of the Arizona Supreme Court.

IT IS FURTHER ENCOURAGED that all parties continue to work towards the resolution and settlement of the cases subject to this Order.
