Pima County Consolidated Justice Court Responds to COVID-19 (Coronavirus)

PIMA COUNTY, AZ. – In response to the COVID-19 epidemic, and to help ensure the safety of our community, judiciary, and court staff, the Pima County Consolidated Justice Court is taking the following actions:

Any person who is ill, has recently traveled, is 65 or older, or whose health is compromised should not come to court. If you are scheduled for a hearing and need to request a continuance, file a motion on our website at www.jp.pima.gov, email us at customerservice@jp.pima.gov, or call us at 520-724-3171.

Business Hours and Current Hearings

Justice Court remains open for business Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM for all matters. However, in order to reduce foot traffic in the courthouse and protect your safety, **Night Court on March 25th has been canceled.**

Additionally, **the majority of court hearings will be reset. You will be notified by mail of your new hearing date.**

Payments

If possible, please make your court payments online at www.jp.pima.gov or contact the court and we will accept payment by telephone. If a warrant has been issued for your arrest, you may come to the courthouse during business hours to have it resolved.

Weddings

Courthouse weddings previously scheduled will proceed throughout the end of this week. Effective Monday, March 23, 2020, wedding ceremonies will be discontinued for a minimum of two weeks. You may contact the court at 520-724-3505 to schedule a private wedding.
