ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 2020-001

**IN RE: USE OF INTERACTIVE AUDIO VISUAL SYSTEMS DURING PUBLIC
HEALTH EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Arizona declared a statewide emergency due to concerns for the spread of the COVID-19 virus; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Justice of the Arizona Supreme Court entered Administrative Order No. 2020-47 intended to limit in-person contacts in Arizona courts to the greatest extent possible consistent with core constitutional rights.

IT IS ORDERED that for all in-custody defendants, every hearing set forth in Rules of Criminal Procedure, Rule 1.5(c)(1), shall be conducted by interactive audiovisual system unless otherwise ordered by the judge assigned to a particular case under extraordinary circumstances.
