Section 1-802 of the Arizona Code of Judicial Administration (ACJA) establishes the State-Federal Judicial Council. The Council, which has been inactive for the past several years, is comprised of state and federal judiciary representatives appointed by the Chief Justice of the Arizona Supreme Court and the Chief Judge of the District of Arizona.

The Chief Judge of the District of Arizona and the Chief Justice of the Arizona Supreme Court have agreed to reactivate the Council to facilitate communication between judges of the state and federal judiciary of Arizona concerning matters of mutual interest and concern.

Now, therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution and ACJA Section 1-802,

IT IS ORDERED that, notwithstanding the membership provisions of ACJA, the following persons are appointed to serve on the State-Federal Judicial Council:

Presiding Judge, Yuma County

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Office of the Courts shall provide staff for the Council, to the extent resources permit doing so and support is needed.
