Administrative Order No. 2009-47 was entered on July 1, 2009. The Order adopted Section 6-311, Detention Operations in the Arizona Code of Judicial Administration, Part 6, Chapter 3, § 6-311 (D)(1) which states:

The administrative director shall establish a detention operations standards advisory committee. The committee shall consist of seven members appointed by the administrative director. The committee shall meet as needed to advise the administrative director concerning changes in the detention operations standards. The majority of the members shall constitute a quorum.

Now therefore, pursuant to ACJA § 6-311 D(1),

IT IS ORDERED that the Juvenile Detention Operations Standards Advisory Committee is established as follows:

1. **Purpose:** The Juvenile Detention Operations Standards Advisory Committee shall at a minimum review the following:
  - a. Establish standards for the timeline as to when juvenile detention case files can be destroyed (expunged),
  - b. Review and revise the standards concerning strip searches and creating criteria to establish reasonable suspicion,
  - c. Develop standards concerning law enforcement access to detained youth,
  - d. Review and update the standards to ensure compliance with the recently-enacted Prison Rape Elimination Act of 2003 (PREA) federal standards,
  - e. Review the standard section on staffing ratios and provide clarification on staffing patterns for a facility,
  - f. Review and modify general verbiage in the standards, with a focus on the academic and health sections, and
  - g. Develop a glossary section for the standards.

2. **Membership:** The individuals listed in Appendix A are appointed as members of the Committee effective upon signature of this Order and ending July 31, 2014.
3. **Meetings:** Committee meetings shall be scheduled at the discretion of the Chair of the Committee.
4. **Staff:** The Administrative Office of the Courts, Juvenile Justice Services Division, shall provide staff for the Committee.
5. **Report:** A report shall be provided to the juvenile court directors, the Committee on Juvenile Court, and the Administrative Director for consideration and action.
