On July 23, 2013, Administrative Directive No. 2013-26 was entered granting a waiver of ACJA § 6-106(F)(1)(a) regarding the educational requirements allowing the Presiding Judge in Cochise County to promote Ed Gilligan to the position of Cochise County Chief Probation Officer.

It has come to the Administrative Director's attention that information needs to be amended to replace the language "The waiver will provide the Cochise County Probation Department the ability to promote a current staff member to the position of chief probation officer, contingent on meeting these requirements within the 2013 calendar year." with "The waiver will provide the Cochise County Probation Department the ability to appoint an applicant to the position of chief probation officer, contingent on meeting these requirements within a reasonable time." Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Administrative Directive No. 2013-26 is amended to read "The waiver will provide the Cochise County Probation Department the ability to appoint an applicant to the position of chief probation officer, contingent on meeting these requirements within a reasonable time."
