On November 8, 2006, this Court signed an administrative order that authorized the Clerk of the Superior Court in Maricopa County to implement an Electronic Court Record Pilot Project to dispose of certain paper documents filed with the Clerk on and after January 1, 2007, provided that the paper had been replaced with electronically maintained images and specifying additional requirements to ensure adherence to all applicable rules and statutes governing the preservation, destruction of, and access to court records.

The pilot project has been a success to date, and this Court has an interest in furthering the original objectives of this pilot as part of the Supreme Court's overall strategic plan.

Now, therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that the provisions, requirements and exceptions of the Electronic Court Record Pilot Project, previously established by this Court in Administrative Order No. 2006-96, are amended to apply to documents in the Superior Court in Maricopa County filed prior to January 1, 2007 in cases established on and after January 1, 2002.
