Pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution, the Supreme Court exercises administrative authority over all courts of the state through the Administrative Office of the Courts.

Pursuant to the foregoing authority, the Supreme Court issued Administrative Order Nos. 94-45 and 94-63 that temporarily placed administrative authority for the Apache Junction Municipal Court with the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Pinal County. Considering the amount of time that has passed since the issuance of the aforementioned administrative orders, the lack of further reported issues in the court, and after consulting with the Presiding Judge of Pinal County, no information exists to warrant the continued seizure of the court.

Now therefore, pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that Administrative Order Nos. 94-45 and 94-63 are hereby rescinded.
