In accordance with the Arizona Code of Judicial Administration, § 1-104, the Chief Justice may establish standing committees to the Arizona Judicial Council to assist the Council in carrying out its responsibilities.

Under the authority granted to the Chief Justice by the Arizona Constitution, Article VI, Section 3, the Arizona Judicial Branch 2011 Achievement Awards Selection Committee is established. Therefore, after due consideration,

IT IS ORDERED that the Arizona Judicial Branch Achievement Awards for 2011 shall be presented to individuals, groups or courts who have made substantial contributions to the following categories: Strengthening the Administration of Justice; Maintaining a Professional Workforce and Improving Operational Efficiencies; Improving Communications; Protecting Children, Families, and Communities; and Improving the Legal Profession. The awards shall be presented at the Annual Court Leadership Conference.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the following individuals are appointed to the Arizona Judicial Branch 2011 Achievement Awards Selection Committee for the express purpose of considering the Achievement Awards 2011 nominations. Committee members shall serve at the pleasure of the Chief Justice.

The appointed members shall make award recommendations to the Arizona Supreme Court and shall hold their appointed position beginning on this date and expiring on October 28, 2011.
