Pursuant to the Constitution of Arizona, Article VI, the Supreme Court has administrative supervision over all courts of the state.

Whereas, effective the end of business day on May 9, 2014, South Tucson Municipal Court is without a presiding judge, the assignment of the interim judge or judges is necessary to ensure the independent and proper operation of the court until a successor presiding judge is appointed by the city council. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that until further order of the Court, administrative supervision of the South Tucson Municipal Court shall be assumed by the Honorable Sarah Simmons, Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Pima County.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Presiding Judge Simmons may issue such orders, including assignment of an interim judge or judges, as may be required to ensure the independent and proper operations of the South Tucson Municipal Court.
