Administrative Order

The Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Maricopa County has requested the assignment of a judge of Division One of the Arizona Court of Appeals to serve in that court to aid and assist in the consideration and disposition of a calendar on January 13, 2015 and January 16, 2015. Therefore, pursuant to Article 6, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that, in addition to his regular duties as a judge of Division One of the Arizona Court of Appeals, the Honorable Samuel Thumma is assigned to serve as a judge in the Maricopa County Superior Court in the above-designated matter, as designated by the Presiding Judge.

While serving as a judge in the designated matter, Judge Samuel Thumma shall have all of the powers and duties of a judge of the Maricopa County Superior Court. These powers and duties shall be extended for the purpose of hearing and determining any proceeding necessary to a final determination of a cause heard in whole or in part during the period of this assignment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this assignment is conditioned upon the agreement by Judge Samuel Thumma to serve in the Superior Court in Maricopa County for the designated matter and to do so for no additional compensation or benefits, fiscal or otherwise.
