The Supreme Court of Arizona’s strategic agenda, *Advancing Justice Together*, calls for process improvements to better serve the public. The Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) has entered into an agreement with a private vendor to allow the public to pay fines and penalties online, statewide. This new payment option requires the assessment of a fee to support the program cost.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that a fee of \$5.00 shall be assessed for each transaction processed through the Online Citation Payment Service.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the AOC shall deposit the revenue generated from this fee into the Fines/Fees and Restitution Enforcement Program account identified in Administrative Order No. 2003-126.
