On December 23, 2015, this Court entered Administrative Order No. 2015-126, establishing the Committee on Civil Justice Reform (“the Committee”). The Committee presented its final report to the Arizona Judicial Council (“AJC”) in October 2016. The report recommended the filing of a petition requesting amendments to various Rules of Civil Procedure, and the AJC unanimously supported this recommendation.

The Committee anticipates filing a rule petition by January 10, 2017. The Committee would thereafter review and respond to comments during the 2017 rule cycle. The Committee’s term currently expires on January 1, 2017.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED extending the term of the Committee on Civil Justice Reform (“Committee”) to August 31, 2017.
