Pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution, the Supreme Court exercises administrative authority over all courts of the state through the Administrative Office of the Courts.

Pursuant to the foregoing authority, the Supreme Court issued Administrative Order No. 2014-10 placing administrative authority for the Maricopa Municipal Court and Maricopa Justice Court with the Presiding Judge of Superior Court in Pinal County. The Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Pinal County has recently confirmed that his continued administrative oversight of these courts is no longer warranted.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2014-10 is rescinded.
