It has come to the Court's attention that additional clarification is needed for the Clerks of Court who will be implementing eFile.AZCourts.gov in the coming months.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3 of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that Clerks of Court shall accept an electronically-submitted proposed order or proposed judgment when attached to a notice of filing or other lead document. The Clerk shall file-stamp and docket the lead document in the publicly-accessible register of actions/docket. The accompanying proposed order or proposed judgment shall not be file-stamped or made accessible by the public. The Clerk shall create an automated log entry in the Clerk's case management system showing receipt of the proposed order or proposed judgment, but the log entry shall not be included in the publicly-accessible register of actions/docket.
