The Arizona Code of Judicial Administration (ACJA) § 6-113: Firearms Standards; specifically ACJA § 6-113(F)(1), and ACJA § 1-302: Education and Training; specifically ACJA § 6-302(K)(3)(d)(2), require probation and surveillance officers to complete annual firearms requalification training. Due to recent events that involved the loss of a Yuma County Surveillance Officer, the Chief Probation Officer and Director of Juvenile Court have requested an extension of time for their officers to complete the annual requalification requirement.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, section 3, of the Arizona Constitution and good cause shown,

IT IS ORDERED that probation and surveillance officers in Yuma County have until January 31, 2018 to complete firearms requalification training.
