Administrative Order No. 2017-10 requires attorneys to electronically file civil case documents when filing into the Superior Court in Yavapai County, based upon a phased implementation schedule commencing April 3, 2017.

While e-filing of civil cases is now available in the Superior Court in Yavapai County through <https://efile.azcourts.gov/>, work is underway to add www.Turbocourt.com as a second e-filing service provider.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3 of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that Administrative Order No. 2017-10 shall be rescinded and mandatory e-filing in the Superior Court in Yavapai County is postponed until further order of the Court.
