Administrative Order

The Presiding Judge of the Maricopa County Superior Court has requested the assignment of a judge of the Arizona Court of Appeals to act as a Superior Court Judge in the Juvenile Department for the purpose of finalizing an adoption on April 17, 2017. Therefore, pursuant to Article 6, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that, in addition to his regular duties as judge of Division One of the Arizona Court of Appeals, the Honorable James P. Beene is assigned to serve as a judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County on April 17, 2017. While serving as a judge in the assigned matters, Judge Beene shall have all of the powers and duties of a Superior Court judge.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this assignment is conditioned upon the agreement by Judge Beene to serve in the Superior Court for any matters designated and to do so for no additional compensation or benefits, fiscal or otherwise.
