The Chief Judge of Division Two of the Arizona Court of Appeals has requested the assignment of a judge of the Superior Court of Arizona to serve in that court to aid and assist in the consideration and disposition of *Brian McDonald v. Mark Napier, Pima County Sheriff, et al.*, 2 CA-CV 2016-0155. Therefore, pursuant to Article 6, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that, in addition to his regular duties as judge of the Superior Court of Arizona, the Honorable James L. Conlogue is assigned to the above-mentioned case. While serving as a judge in the Court of Appeals, Division Two, the Honorable James L. Conlogue shall have all of the powers and duties of a judge of the Court of Appeals, including hearing and determining any proceeding necessary to a final determination of the cause heard in whole or in part.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this assignment is conditioned upon the agreement by the above-named judge to serve in Division Two of the Arizona Court of Appeals for any matters designated and to do so for no additional compensation or benefits, fiscal or otherwise.
