On October 15, 2013, by Administrative Order No. 2013-84, Justice John Pelander was appointed to serve as Vice Chief Justice of the Arizona Supreme Court for a five-year term.

Justice Pelander has resigned his position as Vice Chief Justice and therefore will not fulfill his term as Vice Chief Justice.

Pursuant to Article VI, § 3 of the Arizona Constitution, the members of the Court met in administrative conference on January 24, 2018 to elect the Vice Chief Justice to fill the unexpired term of Vice Chief Justice Pelander. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the Honorable Robert M. Brutinel shall serve as Vice Chief Justice of the Arizona Supreme Court to complete the unexpired term of Justice Pelander.
