Pursuant to the Constitution of Arizona, Article VI, the Supreme Court has administrative supervision over all courts of the state through its Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC).

It has come to the Court's attention that the Presiding Judge of the Goodyear Municipal Court will retire at the close of business on October 26, 2018, and a successor will not be appointed by the Goodyear City Council prior to October 26, 2018.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, section 3 of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that until further order of the Court, administrative control and oversight of day-to-day operations of the Goodyear Municipal Court shall be assumed by the Honorable Janet Barton, Presiding Judge, Superior Court in Maricopa County.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order shall remain in effect until a successor assumes duties as the Presiding Judge of the Goodyear Municipal Court.
