On October 17, 2012, the Steering Committee on Arizona Case Processing Standards (the Committee) was established by Administrative Order No. 2012-80. Through Administrative Order No. 2017-132, the Supreme Court extended the term of the Committee through December 31, 2018.

The Committee has completed its review of 13 case types and obtained formal adoption of case processing standards for them through Administrative Order Nos. 2014-108, 2015-60, 2015-99, and 2016-50. In addition, the Committee has five more case types to review and will recommend the final adoption of case processing standards. In order to complete its task, the Committee has requested an extension of its term to continue to review and recommend final case processing standards for the remaining case types to the Arizona Supreme Court for its approval and adoption.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that the term of the Steering Committee on Arizona Case Processing Standards is extended to December 31, 2019.
