Pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution, the Supreme Court exercises administrative supervision over all courts of the state through the Administrative Office of the Courts.

The Court has been notified that Judge Michael Goimarac will be resigning his position as Magistrate of the Sedona Municipal Court effective October 1, 2019, thereby leaving this court without a presiding judge.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that effective October 1, 2019, administrative control and oversight of day-to-day operations of the Sedona Municipal Court shall be assumed by the Honorable David Mackey, Presiding Judge of the Arizona Superior Court in Yavapai County, and Judge Mackey shall assign judicial officers as needed to conduct the court business. Judge Mackey is also authorized to issue such orders as necessary for the court to operate properly.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order shall remain in effect until a successor assumes duties as Presiding Judge of the Sedona Municipal Court. Any cost associated with operating this court, including cost for judicial officers, shall be a city cost.
