Pursuant to Rule 92(a)(4) of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Arizona and Administrative Order No. 2017-79, the Presiding Judge in each county, with the approval of the Supreme Court, shall appoint an Associate Presiding Judge to act during the absence or unavailability of the Presiding Judge.

On June 12, 2019, by Administrative Order No. 2019-08 of the Superior Court in Pima County, the Honorable Kyle Bryson, Presiding Judge, appointed the Honorable Jeffrey T. Bergin as Associate Presiding Judge.

Therefore, in accordance with the provisions of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Arizona and Administrative Order No. 2017-79,

IT IS ORDERED that the Court hereby approves the appointment of the Honorable Jeffrey T. Bergin as Associate Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Pima County and, in accordance with Rule 92(b), he shall serve at the pleasure of the Presiding Judge and exercise and discharge all powers and duties of the Presiding Judge, except that he may not appoint court commissioners or appoint judges permanently to special assignments.
