In February of 2014, Stephanie R. Vance sat for the uniform bar examination. Ms. Vance received a passing score and, pursuant to Rules of the Supreme Court, Rule 37(a)(1), Ms. Vance had until February 26, 2019 to be granted admission to the State Bar of Arizona.

Ms. Vance timely filed her oath and compliance document seeking admission and upon receipt of the document Certification and Licensing Division staff requested supplemental information related to the admission process. During processing, staff's review of the supplemental information received from Ms. Vance was inadvertently delayed. As such, notwithstanding Rule 37(a)(1), Ms. Vance shall be given additional time to complete the admission process.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution

IT IS ORDERED that Stephanie R. Vance shall have until April 12, 2019 at 5:00 p. m. to complete the admission process and become admitted to the State Bar of Arizona.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if Stephanie Vance fails to be admitted to the State Bar of Arizona by April 12, 2019 at 5:00p.m., her February 2014 uniform bar examination score shall be void for the purposes of admission to the State Bar of Arizona.
