Pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution, the Supreme Court exercise administrative supervision over all courts of the state through the Administrative Office of the Courts.

It has come to the Court's attention that the Williams Municipal Court has been without a presiding magistrate, and currently has no judicial officer.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that administrative control and oversight of day-to-day operations of the Williams Municipal Court shall be assumed by the Honorable Mark Moran, Presiding Judge of the Arizona Superior Court in Coconino County, and Judge Moran shall assign judicial officers as needed to conduct the court business. Judge Moran is also authorized to issue such orders as necessary for the court to operate properly.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order shall remain in effect until a successor assumes duties as Presiding Magistrate of the Williams Municipal Court. Any cost associated with operating this court, including cost for judicial officers, shall be a city cost.
