Pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution, the Supreme Court exercises administrative supervision over all courts of the state through the Administrative Office of the Courts.

It has come to the Court's attention that the Guadalupe City Court will be without a presiding magistrate effective July 18, 2019.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that administrative control and oversight of day-to-day operations of the Guadalupe City Court shall be assumed by the Honorable Janet Barton, Presiding Judge of the Arizona Superior Court in Maricopa County, and Judge Barton shall assign judicial officers as needed to conduct the court business. Judge Barton is also authorized to issue such orders as necessary for the court to operate properly.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order shall remain in effect until a successor assumes duties as Presiding Magistrate of the Guadalupe City Court. Any cost associated with operating this court, including cost for judicial officers, shall be a city cost.
