PRO TEMPORE ORDER

The presiding judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County has requested the appointment of a court commissioner to serve as a judge pro tempore in that court for the purpose of enhancing the court's ability to process cases. Therefore, pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-141,

IT IS ORDERED that Jay R. Adleman, State Bar #018961 is appointed judge pro tempore to serve the Superior Court in Maricopa County for a term beginning April 25, 2011, and ending June 30, 2011 in accordance with A.R.S. §§ 12-141 et. seq., and will serve as assigned by the presiding judge.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this appointment is conditioned upon the approval of the Maricopa County Board of Supervisors pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-141, and upon the agreement by the appointee to serve for no additional compensation or benefits, fiscal or otherwise, other than that to which he is entitled as a Superior Court Commissioner, as provided in A.R.S. § 12-142(C) and A.R.S. § 12-143 for service as a judge pro tempore.
