PRO TEMPORE ORDER  
No. 2011 - 18

The Chief Judge of the Arizona Court of Appeals, Division One, has requested the appointment of the Honorable Sheldon H. Weisberg, following his retirement beginning July 1, 2011, to serve as a judge pro tempore in that court for the purpose of participating in the resolution of those cases in which he previously participated. In accordance with the authority granted to the Chief Justice by Article 6, Section 3 of the Arizona Constitution, and pursuant to A.R.S. §12-145,

IT IS ORDERED that the Honorable Sheldon H. Weisberg is appointed to serve as a judge pro tempore in the Arizona Court of Appeals, Division One, beginning July 1, 2011, and ending October 31, 2011, and is authorized to participate in the resolution of those cases in which he previously participated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this appointment is conditioned upon the agreement by the appointee to serve for no compensation or benefits, fiscal or otherwise, as provided in A.R.S. §12-146(C).
