PRO TEMPORE ORDER

The presiding judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in Yuma County has requested the appointment of a judge pro tempore in the Superior Court for the purpose of maintaining the court's ability to process cases while all other judges in Yuma County are attending the Annual Judicial Conference to be held June 25 to June 28, 2014. Alicia Aguirre, an attorney, meets all of the qualifications of a judge pro tempore as provided in A.R.S. § 12-142. Therefore, pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-141,

IT IS ORDERED that Alicia Aguirre, State Bar #021415, is appointed judge pro tempore of the Superior Court in Yuma County for a term beginning June 25, 2014 and ending June 28, 2014, and is to serve as assigned by the presiding judge.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this appointment is conditioned upon the approval of the Yuma County Board of Supervisors pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-141, and upon the Superior Court in Yuma County obtaining appropriate funding from whatever source for the compensation due to said appointee pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-142(C) and § 12-143 for service as a judge pro tempore.
