AOC, APSD has adopted practices to give additional supervision credit to some specialty populations for funding and reporting purposes. **Credit for dangerous crimes against children wGPS are given against a ratio of 3 to 1 (3:1).** **Credit for Standard and Intensive Reentry 90 day Pre Release are given at a ratio of 1 to 1 (1:1).** Please see Administrative Order No. 2006-90 and Administrative Directive No. 2011-41 (F). Standard cases are considered by the legislature for funding purposes in all counties but Maricopa, where probation supervision is county funded.
