

COURT PERSONNEL

Statewide Narrative Summary

The statewide summary reflects all court positions as of June 30, 2011, including positions funded from both primary and non-primary budget sources. The information was reported by the individual courts and probation departments in response to the Supreme Court personnel survey distributed electronically in July 2011.

The total number of persons working full-time in the Arizona judicial system decreased from 9,379 in FY 2010 to 9,290 in FY 2011, a 0.9% decrease. The courts employed an additional 1,069 part-time personnel, down 4.2% from 1,116 in FY 2010.

The most notable decrease in full-time personnel appear to be in the position of “Surveillance Officer” category (190 to 158). The largest increase in full-time personnel appears to be in the position of “Detention Support Staff” category (22 to 44).

The courts also had the services of 2,152 regular volunteers, a decrease of 4.3% from the 2,249 in FY 2010. Volunteers include attorneys, court reporters, teachers, mediators, information desk personnel, Court Appointed Special Advocates, Foster Care Review Board members, and other professionals and non-professionals who serve as on-call magistrates.

Additionally, the courts utilized 137,803 hours of temporary personnel assistance. This is equivalent to 17,225 person-days, or slightly over 66 full-time employees (at 260 working days per year).

Some of the FY 2010 figures may not correspond to figures published in last year's Data Report due to corrected information received subsequent to publication of the Report. Personnel reports received from courts are checked for anomalies, but are not audited by the Supreme Court.
