
SUPREME COURT Narrative Summary

During fiscal year 2014, there were 1,037 cases filed in the Supreme Court, a decrease of 1.6% from the 1,054 cases filed during FY 2013. The categories with the most significant change over the year include the special action-other category which increased by 17.2%, and the state bar matters, which decreased 14.5%. Of the petitions for review, the civil and juvenile case types experienced the largest decrease in filings, dropping by 5.7% and 36.1%, respectively. Criminal petitions for review had the greatest increase in filings with an overall increase of 4.6%, or 20 case filings.

During the same period, the Supreme Court disposed of 978 cases, a decrease of 14.6% from the 1,145 cases disposed during the previous fiscal year.


The difference between filings and terminations resulted in a pending caseload increase of 18.6%, from 334 cases on July 1, 2013 to 396 cases on June 30, 2014.



COURT OF APPEALS - DIVISION ONE
Narrative Summary

Division One of the Court of Appeals experienced a decrease in case filings during fiscal year 2014. Original filings decreased by 6.4%, from 2,809 in FY 2013 to 2,630 in FY 2014. An additional 53 cases were reinstated or transferred in during the year. Criminal appeal filings increased from 483 to 561, an increase of 16.1%. Juvenile filings were also up 10.5% from 313 to 346 in FY 2014. The category with the most significant decreased filings was Unemployment board which was down 66.1%, from 292 in FY 2013 to 99 in FY 2014. Post-conviction relief, special actions and civil appeal filings also decreased from FY 2013 to FY 2014.

Total case dispositions decreased from 2,936 in FY 2013 to 2,443 in FY 2014, a decrease of 16.8%. The unemployment board category had the most significant change over the fiscal year, decreasing 61.1% from FY 2013 to FY 2014. Civil, criminal and post-conviction relief case types also saw decreased terminations while mental health, juvenile and special action terminations increased.


The total pending caseload increased by 57 cases from 2,051 on July 1, 2013 to 2,108 on June 30, 2014, an increase of 2.8%.



COURT OF APPEALS - DIVISION TWO Narrative Summary

Filings in Division Two of the Court of Appeals decreased by 7.1% from 842 in FY 2013 to 782 in FY 2014. Additionally there were 179 cases, primarily post-conviction relief cases, transferred into the court during the fiscal year. All case types experienced decreased filings from FY 2013 to FY 2014, with the exception of Juvenile filings which increased 8.7%.

Dispositions increased by 11.1%, from 1,046 in FY 2013 to 1,162 in FY 2014. The most notable increases occurred in the post-conviction relief and juvenile case categories which increased 41.6% and 15.6%, respectively. While most case types had increased terminations, the civil category decreased from 219 in FY 2013 to 177 in FY 2014, a decrease of 19.2%.

As a result of the decreased filings and increased terminations, the total pending caseload figure decreased from 870 at the end of FY 2013 to 656 at the end of FY 2014, a decrease of 24.6%.




COURT OF APPEALS, DIVISION TWO
