

## **COURT PERSONNEL**

### **Statewide Narrative Summary**

The statewide summary reflects all court positions as of June 30, 2015, including positions funded from both primary and non-primary budget sources. The information was reported by the individual courts and probation departments in response to the Supreme Court personnel survey distributed electronically in June 2015.

The total number of persons working full-time in the Arizona judicial system decreased from 9,444 in FY 2014 to 9,318 in FY 2015, a decrease of 1.3%. The courts employed an additional 989 part-time personnel, down 7.0% from 1,064 in FY 2014.

Notable changes in position categories include decreases in “legal research/assistance”, “Probation/Detention Administrative” and “Pre-Sentence Probation Officers” positions. Full time Judicial and Other Magisterial positions decreased by 25 positions, or 5.0%. Of the total funded positions statewide, 6.9% of full time and 18.8% of part time positions were reported as vacant at the end of FY 2015. Of the part time positions, 364 or 36.8%, are classified as Judicial or Other Magisterial.

The courts also had the services of 2,547 regular volunteers, an decrease of 7.1% from the 2,741 in FY 2014. Volunteers include attorneys, court reporters, teachers, mediators, information desk personnel, Court Appointed Special Advocates, Foster Care Review Board members, and other professionals and non-professionals who serve as on-call magistrates.

Additionally, the courts utilized 176,674 hours of temporary personnel assistance. This is equivalent to 21,709 person-days, or 83 full-time employees.

Some of the FY 2014 figures may not correspond to figures published in last year's Data Report due to corrected information received subsequent to publication of the Report. Personnel reports received from courts are checked for anomalies, but are not audited by the Supreme Court.
