**SUMMARY:**

- Development already underway on statewide systems/projects, previously approved, including CMS and e-filing development / implementation activities
- Enhancements requested by the GJ CMS Steering Committee
- Any new initiatives presented having Statewide impact

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

**Operating Budget and Ongoing Projects** – Includes maintenance of network, applications, and technical support as well as improvements for shared services provided to courts. CACC and the steering committees continue to monitor the LJ CMS efforts underway. AOC’s Court Services Division continues to monitor the AZTurboCourt, eBench, and eAccess efforts.

Recommend Approval of remaining milestone funding for statewide projects.

**GJ Case Management System Enhancements**, the next iteration of GJ improvements, and completion of any prior enhancements to functionality remaining from prior years need to be funded for FY15.

**ACTION OPTIONS:**

**FUND THE OPERATION OF EXISTING STATEWIDE SYSTEMS AND CONTINUED DEVELOPMENT OF PREVIOUSLY AUTHORIZED STATEWIDE PROJECTS, INCLUDING ONGOING GJ CMS ENHANCEMENTS:**

1. Approve the funding of existing operations and ongoing statewide projects, as presented.
2. Approve the funding of existing operations and ongoing statewide projects with changes, as documented.
3. Withhold approval for the funding of existing operations and ongoing statewide projects, not recommending further operation of existing statewide systems or development of new ones.
4. Table the consideration of funding of existing operations and continuation of current projects for later discussion.
