Administrative Order 2014-04, adopted on December 9, 2014, established the Court of Appeals Pro Bono Representation Program, which provides pro bono counsel to pro se parties in selected civil and juvenile appeals and special actions identified by the Court. At that time, the Court appointed Kimberly A. Demarchi, Esq., as the Pro Bono Attorney Coordinator for Division One to recruit and coordinate private volunteer attorneys for the Pro Bono Program. Due to a changed professional affiliation of Kimberly A. Demarchi resulting in changed circumstances,

IT IS ORDERED relieving Kimberly A. Demarchi of her obligations as Pro Bono Attorney Coordinator for Division One and, in her place, appointing Eric Fraser, Esq., and Hayleigh Crawford, Esq., of Osborn Maledon, P.A., as Pro Bono Attorney Coordinators for Division One, who shall recruit and coordinate private volunteer attorneys for the Pro Bono Program in Division One.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon notification by the Court that the Court has placed a case in the Program, these Pro Bono Attorney Coordinators will endeavor to identify a volunteer attorney who is ready, willing and able to accept the representation, consistent with the directives in Administrative Order 2014-04 and the Court of Appeals Pro Bono Representation Program Manual.
