## Formal and Informal Advisory Ethics Opinion Requests

Pursuant to Rule 82(d) of the Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court, [a] dvisory [ethics] opinions may be requested by a judge or candidate for judicial office, by a court, by an agency charged with judicial administration, by a judicial employee, or by any member of the advisory committee."
