On [] I was brought to the [] Police Department for a lie detector test and interrogated. I am believed to be a suspect of a stolen bike and a burglary that supposedly took place at [] [] They took my shoes to be analyzed. The shoes I was wearing at the time were given to me by [] in the 3rd week of October. I also have a signed statement to prove that. So I didn't even have the shoes in July when the crime was committed. Detective [] also noticed that the shoes I had on were not the same as the ones that left the prints at the scene. I am being falsely accused of the crimes I am accused of and feel that the judicial system here in [] County should release me immediately until they find the right person or persons responsible. I was arrested and released on [] and on [] I found I had a warrant so on [] I turned myself back in. Because I feel I have done nothing wrong and have been held in custody with a high bond and cannot pay the amount. And now I am behind on paying my bills I since have suffered 3 heart attacks and suffer from mental anguish and emotional stress.
