The investigation revealed that the judge lived near the parents, but did not know them and had never met them except in court. There is no evidence that the judge was biased.

The complaint is dismissed pursuant to Rule 16(a).

[REDACTED] I have been to [REDACTED] Superior Court twice, once on [REDACTED] and the latest was [REDACTED] both hearings were for modification to our current visitation order. To make a long story short, my ex and his wife have been arrested for domestic violence several times and I have significant reason to worry about my 11 year old child at their house. Not only that but my son is devastated each time I have to force him to go on his biweekly visits.

BOTH TIMES we went to court [REDACTED] has openly admitted to knowing my exes family on a personal level, and yet throughout the case he showed signs of favoritism.

In this last case [REDACTED] he stated that he lived down the street from my ex when he was just a young boy and he has known his family for a very long time.

He dismissed all of the evidence we provided, which was ALL DOCUMENTED stuff, such as domestic violence records, the fact that step moms father is a convicted child molester AND is stated as HIGH RISK.

The judge did not hear us out at all, and I feel I was misrepresented by the court system twice, and now the person who suffers from this loss is my 11 year old son, because this judge refused to let us defend ourselves, and/or hear us out.

There has been substantial abuse reported over the years in this house and I find it so hard to believe that a judge could throw a child into that and completely disregard his feelings. As for myself, I have no police record, but was made to look like a fool in front of this judge, and these other people.

I have ordered a copy of the transcripts from the court hearing yesterday and will be more than happy to supply them if needed.
