The orders of protection office is unlawfully harassing myself & my family. On & off for years now the [redacted] Police has instructed to obtain Inj against harassment Petitions against certain neighbors of ours. On the one occasion that a neighbor obtained one against us he was refused to prohibit us from video taping. He was refused. Because we had submitted a video tape to the police of him breaking the law - thus him & his family wanted us not to video tape them anymore breaking the law. As I said your court denied them this. Since then this family has vandalized our home for over # [redacted] & now you suddenly GIVE them an Inj to stop us from protecting our home so they can further vandalize & perhaps kill us without any proof!

On [redacted] we had an hearing where our neighbor tried to fight his inj, this was denied & it remained in effect. But we were denied - REFUSED the right to show our video taped evidence of what was going on, PROOF of what we video tape. We were unintentionally denied the right to show it, but the judge instructed the defendant to get an Inj against us to stop our video taping, without even seeing what was being taped. This again, is unlawful & harassment against myself & my family.

Also the witness that appeared on [redacted] also has vandalized our home & has had 3 inj against her but suddenly she is allowed to prohibit us from protecting our home & our lives against her.

We demand these unlawfully Inj against myself & my family be revoked & a hearing done to see if they are needed. ?

→ We were denied the right to provide evidence - video tape!

I have already had 2 strokes & my daughter - as the court is aware - is not at all well & the court harrasses us!
