**ORDER**

A review of the complaint filed in this matter reveals that the issues raised are solely legal or appellate in nature and do not involve allegations of ethical misconduct. The complainant states that his son was wrongfully convicted and then sentenced by the judge for of a crime he did not commit and for which he would have been exonerated if a videotaped confession by the victim would have been allowed into evidence.

It is clear on the face of the complaint that the complainant is seeking to overturn the judge's ruling. Because the commission is not an appellate court and cannot change a judge's decisions, the complaint is dismissed pursuant to Rule 16(a).
